



New Appointment Scheduler Report

The Avanta Appointment Scheduler now features a brand new report. The Appointment Report lists patients with appointments matching various criteria such as a patient's appointment reason, resource, location, and even keywords in the appointment note area. This report also provides the option



of reporting on all appointments created, changed, confirmed, or deleted based on the date, user, and/or appropriate confirmation or deletion reason.

Additional features of the Appointment Report include checking for "no show" appointments and creating a group of patients by various report criteria. You also have the option to select the appointment information that is printed on the report and how the report is sorted.

If your Avanta system has been updated within the last month or so, this report is already available to you. If you have not been updated recently, Dan will be contacting your office soon to schedule an update (see "Updates In-Progress!" article).
